





## The UMC Clergy Financial Well-Being Initiative Educational Projects 2017-2019

Since 2017, Wespath Benefits and Investments\* has partnered with others, including the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry and the National Association of United Methodist Foundations to provide financial support to increase clergy financial literacy through financial education across the country. This chart summarizes those projects including the sponsor or host entity, a brief description and the purpose of the grant funds. Projects range from less than 20 to over 200 participants with funding levels from under \$5,000 to approximately \$20,000. United Methodist foundations have been important partners in many of these projects. These projects are all collaborative endeavors with financial contributions from multiple entities.
